2. What more information or knowledge do you need to form this goal?
3. How will you know if you are making progress towards your goal? What are things you can watch that will tell you if you are moving closer or away from this goal?
4. What are the main grass species that you are familiar with on lands you manage?
5. What's one thing you could do if you wanted to facilitate continued grass growth and dominance in your pasture or rangeland?
6. What tells you when it is time to enter a pasture (grass height? Time of year?)? How about leave a pasture?
7. How do you/ would you keep track of pasture management info, like information on how long you stayed in the pasture, what indicators you used to exit and enter, and other information (notebook? App? Chart? In your head?)
8. What do you/ will you watch for that would tell you if the pasture was moving in an undesirable direction (For example, increase in bare ground? Increase in grazing resistant species or undesirable species? Other?) What's a way you can observe and track these longer-term changes?
