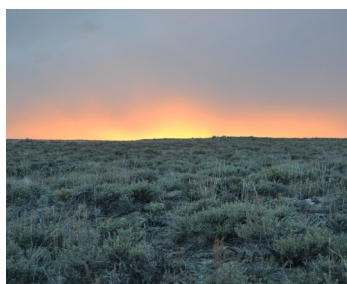


Range Seminar Series
